Responsibilities:

- Attend trainings, June 9 & 10 from 10am-2 pm (& one staff orientation TBD)
- Obtain or update CPR and First Aid certification
- Create daily plans based on existing curriculum with the input of Education Coordinator
- Lead daily bilingual activities with an emphasis on exploration, discovery, fun, and safety
- Supervise & mentor both a youth and an adult volunteer during each camp
- Be a positive and inspiring role model for youth
