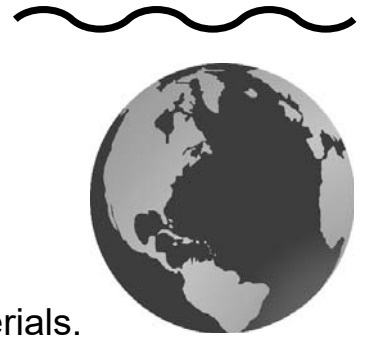


Kids Explore!



Create a Happy Earth Day Card

Celebrate Earth Day by creating a collage card from recycled materials.

Materials

- ◆ Cardboard (from a cereal box)
- ◆ Old magazines and calendars
- ◆ Colorful recycled paper scraps
- ◆ Pretty ribbons and fabric scraps
- ◆ Natural items like bits of lichen, dried leaves, tiny cones
- ◆ Scissors, glue, tape

1. Cut an earth-shaped circle out of cardboard.
2. Find some colorful pictures in magazines

and old calendars that you think show people being kind to the earth. A couple ideas to get you started might include kids riding bikes or people growing gardens.

3. Look also for pictures of your favorite places in nature or living things you think need caretaking. Include a few from nature nearby!
4. Cut your pictures out and glue or tape them to your cardboard earth in a fun design.

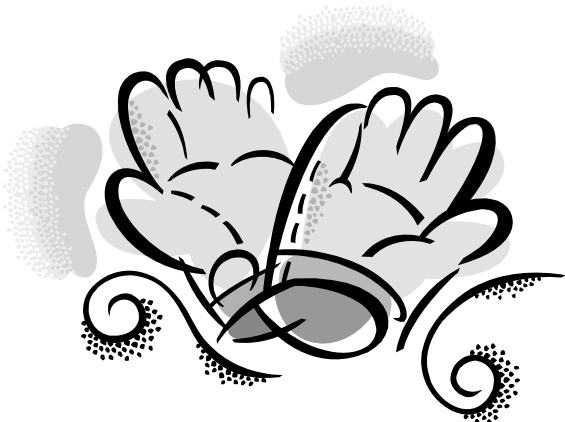
5. Add colorful scraps of paper, ribbons, and fabric plus natural items to
