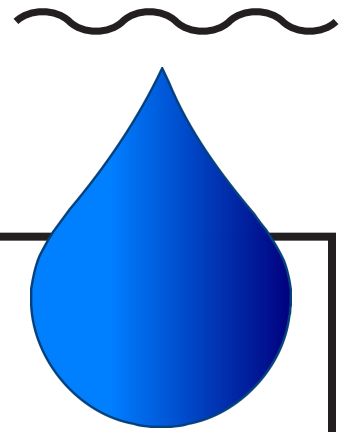


Kids Explore!



Water Wonders Scavenger Hunt

See if you can find the things listed below in nature nearby in this “look but don’t collect” scavenger hunt.

- 1) Something that has veins but is not part of your body
- 2) Something that has been shaped by water
- 3) Something that can float that is not part of a plant (hint: you probably can’t catch this one!)
- 4) Something that drinks water that is not an animal
- 5) Something green that is dry and crunchy in the summer and moist and soft in the winter
- 6) Something soft that helps birds keep dry
- 7) Something tiny and brown that will turn green if you add water, sunlight, and soil
- 8) Something that every living thing needs to survive (hint: you can’t put this in a paper bag!)
- 9) Something hard and brown that is part of a tree’s plumbing system

Possible answers: 1—a leaf, 2—a round rock, 3—a water bird like a duck, 4—a plant, 5—lichen or sometimes grass, 6—a feather, 7—a seed, 8—a sunlight, air, or water, 9—a branch or root
